

Patterns of Power Process

Each grade in *Patterns of Power Plus* is split into ten Lesson Sets that are built around a standard. Six lessons, or invitations, within each Lesson Set are designed to support that standard for a total of sixty lessons per grade. Each Lesson Set contains five to eight days of instruction. We suggest you create a ten-minute daily space for the meaning-making magic of conventions!

Here are two models for a suggested, flexible Lesson Set cycle. You choose what makes sense to you and your writers and the time you have.

Patterns-of-Power Process	
Day 1	Invitation to Notice <i>What do you notice?</i> Generate Focus Phrase
Day 2	Invitation to Compare and Contrast <i>How are they alike and different?</i>
Day 3	Invitation to Imitate <i>Try it out...</i> Shared or interactive imitation Imitate in pairs or independently
Day 4	Invitation to Share and Celebrate
Day 5	Invitation to Apply
Day 6	Invitation to Edit <i>Editing conversations</i> <i>What effect do changes have?</i>
